Learning Community; Dr. Curtis Carroll, CMS Superintendent, West Learning Community; and George Dunlap, Mecklenburg County Commissioner. The panel also included Lionel Means, Pastor of Uplift Christian Ministries and host of the Town Hall Meeting, and Tanisha Ruth Jones, a Behavior Intervention Specialists representing the parent perspective.

The NC NABSE State Leadership Conference takes place February 15 -16, 2018, at the Friendship Missionary Baptist Church Conference Center, 3400 Beatties Ford Road, Charlotte, NC. The Conference will be attended by school superintendents, teachers, administrators, parents, students, and community leaders. NABSE will distribute the ABC Math books to students and parents attending the Conference.

The North Carolina NABSE and its affiliates work in partnership with CMS, City of Charlotte, Mecklenburg County and MBK to sponsor professional development activities and events for parents, students, teachers, school officials and community leaders.
